NEW Equine ID & Measurement Card: OHA will offer a laminated 8-1/2 x 5-1/2 card beginning at the Gold Classic Show. At least one photo will be on the card along with a full description including registration numbers and microchip numbers, the OHA logo and the height of the equine. The card will be temporary until the equine has reached 5 years of age at which time it will become permanent. This will be recognized for all of our height split classes and will serve as a travel ID especially for those of you who have unpapered equines.

Fees will be \$15 for a temporary card, \$25 for a permanent card and \$25 for transfers of ownership. Pat & Rose Berger will be on hand part of each day with official measuring equipment, printer, laminator and camera. A form will be available on our website. If you have several equines you want done, contact Pat at busyb@ipns.com for an appointment at the show. All equines are welcome, not just those exhibiting at the show.
