The fine print:

No equine may compete against itself except for Leadline.

No cross-entry into any other age or size divisions.

Dress code - Show casual dress: Long pants and boots required, no sleeveless tops. English OR Western style accepted for ALL classes. (You don't need to wear English to do the Hunter Class, you don't need to wear Western to do the Ranch Trail class.)

Size Division - Equine size should be based on expected size at maturity. A weanling horse may be pony sized, but should show in horse division.

CH – Champion classes are for first and second place winners from the previous classes. No entry fee for these classes.

Hunter In-Hand can be exhibited at the combination of any speed: walk, trot or canter.

More Stuff:

Limited Participation – Show management will combine or run concurrent classes in order to move the show along in a timely manner.

Leadline – Any age or ability can enter. Some of us just need an extra hand!

Arrival – Please do not arrive prior to 3pm on Saturday. The arenas will be closed until the morning of the show.

Departure – Please be sure to leave no later than 9am on Monday.

Concessions – Available on-site, so no grills or cooking equipment allowed.

Parking - Parking is limited to designated parking areas, including vehicles with trailers and unhitched trailers. Facility will assist in directing traffic for the Event as needed.

Dogs - Dogs are not permitted on the facility grounds.

Equines - No equine shall be left unattended except in a stall or a fully enclosed corral. Do not leave horses tied to a trailer, tree, fence rail or any other obstacle unattended. Users assume any and all risk of harm associated with horses on the premises including but not limited to horses, people and facilities.

Vehicles - Only automobiles, trucks, RVs and horse trailers are permitted on the Premises. Scooters, skateboards, bicycles, roller skates, rollerblades, golf carts, and ATVs are not permitted. ADA approved mobility devices excluded.

Participation Agreement, Notice Release and Acknowledgement of Risk: I accept and clearly understand that riding/handling an equine can be hazardous, especially in an equestrian event; that there are inherent and other risks involved in riding/handling an equine; and that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence. I freely accept and assume those risks. I therefore release Oregon Family Equestrian Activities, Inc. (OFEA), its members and show grounds' owners and all of their agents and employees, from any and all liability for damage and injury to myself, my horse, or to any person or property resulting from my riding/handling a horse in this equestrian event, accepting myself the full responsibility for any and all such damage or injury of any kind which may result. I agree to fully indemnify, defend, and hold OFEA, show grounds' owners and all of their agents and employees, harmless from any and all claims, actions, liability, or costs including attorney fees and other costs of defense, arising out of or in any way related to my riding a horse in this equestrian event. The limitations on liability provided in ORS 30.691 shall apply to an adult participant in the circumstances listed in subsection (1)(b) of this section if the participant, prior to riding, training, driving, grooming or riding as a passenger upon an equine, knowingly executes a release stating that as a condition of participation, the participant waives the right to bring an action against the equine professional or equine activity sponsor for an injury or death arising out of riding, training, driving, grooming or riding as a passenger upon the equine. A release so executed shall be binding upon the adult participant.
